

## RE: INVITATION FOR PRE-QUALIFICATION/EXPRESSION OF INTEREST AND INVITATION TO TENDER

he Universal Service Provision Fund (USPF) wishes to draw the attention of all interested bidders and the public to its earlier advertisements published in Federal Tenders Journal, Daily Trust and This Day of 18<sup>th</sup> April, 2022.

- 2. The Secretariat wishes to inform prospective bidders to note the following:
  - The underlisted projects advertised as Services have been corrected to Works:
    - > The Provision, Upgrade and Management of Bandwidth BA(E) project (Lots 1 to 6)
    - > The Installation, Provision and Management of Bandwidth project BA(N) (Lots 1 to 6)
  - Thus both projects fall under the "Invitation to Tender" category;
  - Bidders must submit evidence of Company Income's Tax Clearance Certificate for the preceding three (3) years (2019, 2020, and 2021) valid till 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022 (with an average minimum annual turnover in the last three years of ₩238 million for BA(E), ₩108 million for BA(N));
  - Bidders must be an Internet Service Provision (ISP) License holder;
  - Tender Documents are obtainable from the Procurement Department of USPF upon payment of a non-refundable tendering fee of Ten Thousand Naira (**N10,000.00**) only per Lot paid into Universal Service Provision Fund's remita account in any reputable Commercial Bank in Nigeria.
  - The submission deadline for the two projects (BA(E) & BA(N)) has now been extended to 10:00am
    Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2022;
  - Only the technical bids for the (BA(E) & BA(N) projects will be opened immediately after the deadline for submission at 10:00am Monday, 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2022;
- 3. All other conditions/information in the original Invitation to Tender advertisement remains valid.
